<p>Who can't give</p>	<p>Corporations, unions, federal contractors, and non-citizens/green card holders</p>						
<p>In-kind definition</p>	<p>A non-monetary contribution to, goods or services offered free or at less than the usual charge for, or when a person or entity pays for services on a committee's behalf is considered an in-kind contribution to the candidate(s) running for public office the Swing Left fund is supporting.</p>
